


% BREAKDOWN OF REPORTED ALERTS PER CONTINENT







Q2 2025 ABC Trends

Analysis: Overview 69 ALERTS


were reported to the relevant authorities in Q2, involving 23 countries and **10 different sports.**



This marks an **8% increase** on the revised figure of **64 alerts** reported in Q1 2025, and a **21% increase** on the Q2 2024 total of **57 alerts**.

Breakdown: Sport-Specific **51 ALERTS**


were reported on football, tennis and basketball in Q2 2025.



This accounts for **74% of Q2 2025 alerts**, consistent with Q1 where football, tennis and basketball made up **78%**.

Comparison: Regional 31%

of the total alerts reported in Q2 involved events in Europe (21 alerts), which is a 40% increase on Q1 (15 alerts).



However, the longer-term data suggests a downward trend in alerts on European sporting events.
